NATIONAL & WORLD EVENTS

Pray for wisdom, honesty and fairness to characterise the ongoing Brexit negotiations. Pray especially for those who feel their careers or businesses may be threatened by potential outcomes.

Pray for God to guide those in power in countries beset with governmental instability which threatens peace and security, such as Zimbabwe, Lebanon, Germany, Syria and Spain. Ask both for His wisdom for the leaders of these nations and for His peace for the countless peoples who live in uncertainty.

Pray for refugees and migrants such as the Rohingya people of Myanmar; the Haitians in the USA who face deportation in 18 months; and refugees throughout Europe, Africa, the Middle East, Asia, Australasia and elsewhere fleeing violence and war.

Pray for those affected by terrorist attacks across the globe, both reported and unreported. Remember victims and their families in Iraq, Afghanistan, Nigeria, Pakistan, and Syria, and closer to home.

Give thanks for the freeing of Billy Irving and his colleagues from Prison in Chennai, India, without charges. Pray for their families as they are reunited after 4 years. Pray that he may receive the right support and that he may experience a complete healing from the trauma he has experienced.

LOCAL EVENTS

Pray that, as Christians, we may be lights to the world. Pray that the true meaning of Christmas will be shared in unexpected places and conversations. Pray that we will be ready to speak about it and what it means to us.

Pray for the services and assemblies that will take place involving the local schools. Pray that children, parents and teachers will hear the Christmas message afresh and with a new understanding.

Pray for all those who will come to Christmas services who don't usually come. Pray that they would know a warm welcome and that their hearts would be touched and challenged by what they hear.

Please also pray for those who will deliver gifts from the churches to the local community. Pray for good conversations and contacts with folk to be made.

Pray for those who will sing carols around Merrylee on the 23rd December. Pray that the singing will bring joy to those who hear it. Pray too that some may even join in the singing!

Pray that many of our members will use this Advent season as an opportunity to share something of what Christmas really means with friends and families and with our local shopkeepers and people we meet in our streets.
